# What is the SHARE Consortium?

The SHARE Consortium is a partnership allowing many libraries to make their collections available to the public via a single online catalog. SHARE's membership has included the libraries of Dodge, Jefferson, Racine, Walworth and Washington counties since 2007.

## What is changing?

On November 20, 2014, the libraries of the Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System (Dodge, Jefferson, & Washington Counties) will no longer be members of the Consortium.

## Why is this happening?

In March of 2014, the Board of Trustees of the Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System voted to withdraw from the Consortium.

#### How will this affect me?

After July 22, 2014, users will no longer be able to search for or place holds on materials which belong to libraries in the Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System. After this date, there may be times when you might notice slightly fewer titles in the SHARE Online Catalog. There may also be times when a book, DVD or other material may take a little longer to arrive after you place it on hold due to fewer libraries in the system.

# Can I still get the materials I want?

Yes. Library staff will have other ways to get materials you would like. One method is by using WISCAT, an online catalog linking the collections of almost all of Wisconsin's public libraries! Ask your librarian for more details, or click the link at the bottom of the SHARE Catalog that says....

"Not finding what you're looking for? Click here to search the state-wide WISCAT catalog!"



\*This process may take a little longer because your book may need to travel farther to get to your library.\*

# Will I need a new Library Card?

That depends. If you already have a library card from any of the Lakeshores Library System member libraries on the back of this brochure, you **WILL NOT** need a new library card. If you currently only have a library card from a Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System member library, then you may be asked to get a new card at the LLS library you use most after November 20, 2014.

New library cards are free.

## How can I prepare?

Most of this transition will happen automatically. However, there are a couple of things you can do prior to and during the transition:

- Review your holds by checking your borrowing account in the SHARE Online Catalog.
- 2. Ask library staff for assistance if you have questions about your borrowing account.

## How can I help?

Library staff will be working very hard to manage these changes with minimal impact on borrowers. There are a couple of things you can do to assist them:

- 1. If the list of holds on a title in the catalog is long, please provide feedback by recommending the item to your library for purchase.
- 2. Consider paying any outstanding bills associated with lost items.
