atheson Memorial Library (MML) is located in downtown Elkhorn, at the intersection of Wisconsin Street & Court Street. MML has 6,455 resident borrowers and 5,940 non-resident borrowers for a total of 12,395 card holders. The library serves residents in the following areas: City of Elkhorn, La Grange, Geneva, Sugar Creek, Lafayette, Delavan Township.

How is the library funded?

2014 revenues were as follows:

\$374,938 from City of Elkhorn

\$319,084 from Walworth & other County taxes

\$68,457 other revenue (fines, Friends and Foundation donations, interest, etc.)
