

he Afternoon Book Club is a relaxed group of people who just enjoy sharing a great book! They meet on the third Wednesday of the month at **2pm.**


November 21st – *Killers of the Flower Moon* by David Grann




PAGE TURNERS EVENING BOOK CLUB




November 27th - Chivalry by Neil Gaiman
