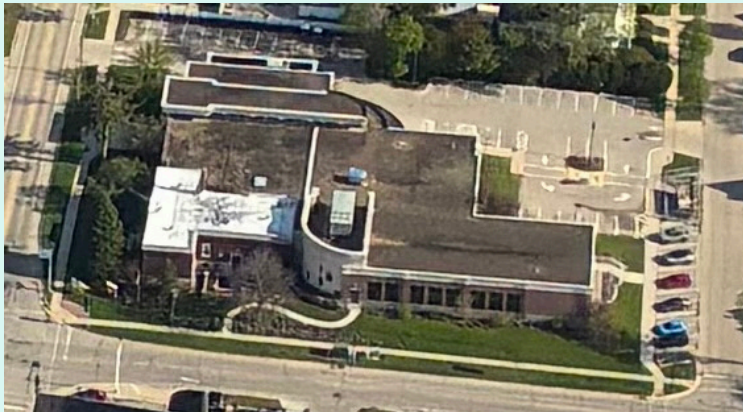

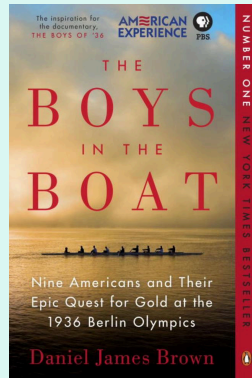
We have a lot of things planned for the Adult Summer Reading program this year! As always, we have reading logs available Saturday, June 6 through Saturday, August 1.

LINDSAY BARNES

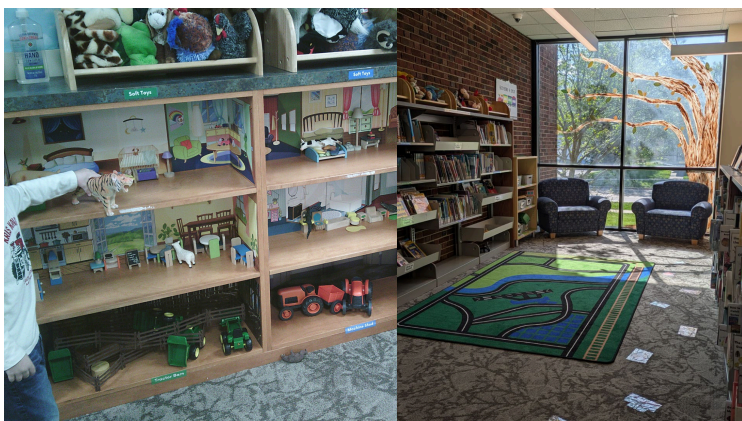
